If you have not had the opportunity to visit the Association's web site, we encourage you to do so. The pages have a fresh new look and have been up-dated with the latest information.

Handicap Information:

Every player in the Amateur and Senior Amateur must have a current active U.S.G.A. GHIN handicap card. The player must be affiliated with a member club. If you print your handicap information from the web at ghin.com, please send your GHIN number along with it.

It is a simple procedure to obtain a handicap card. Talk with the club pro or club manager (at the course where you are a member or where you regularly play) about purchasing a handicap "box." An active handicap card is one that has scores posted to it every year. Handicap cards that have no scores posted in several years can not be considered active.

The GHIN number stays the same from year to year. This number is on the card that will be submitted with the entry to the Amateur and perhaps for other tournaments that are entered. The GHIN number is used to update handicaps prior to the tournament every year.

The Amateur:

Caddies are allowed during The Amateur. Everyone is expected to follow rules of etiquette during the tournament. If you have any questions regarding play, etiquette, or rules during the tournament, please consult a member of the Rules Committee.

In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measure distance only. If, during any round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Carts must be paid for in advance (see entry form). After the Wednesday round, players still in the match play will pay for their cart in the pro shop. Caddies that wish to ride may do so – the cost is \$15 per round. Carts that are not pre-paid for either the player or the caddie may not be available during the first three days. Pace of play will be enforced. Players who walk will be expected to keep pace!

The Annual Business Meeting will be prior to the Banquet on Tuesday, June 24. The Banquet will follow with awards to be presented after the meal. We encourage all players to be present at these events.

There will not be a Better Ball Tournament or Closest to Hole competition during the practice round this year. Non-tournament participants will not be allowed to play during Sunday's Practice Round.
