W.K.S.G.A. CHAMPIONSHIP RUNNER-UP CUP

The cup will be presented to the runner-up of the Women's Kentucky State Amateur Tournament. The runner-up's home club shall be its custodian for two (2) months following the Amateur and then it will be moved to Golf House Kentucky for display until the next year's tournament.

SENIOR MEDALIST TROPHY

Any contestant who will have reached her 55th birthday on or before qualifying day is eligible to win the Pendelton Trophy, donated by Winchester Country Club. **Entry forms must include birth date to qualify.**

JUNIOR MEDALIST

Any contestant who has not reached her 19th birthday on or before qualifying day is eligible to win a special Junior Medalist prize. **Entry forms must include birth date to qualify.**

TEAM CUP

The Team Cup will be competed for during the qualifying round. The lowest aggregate gross score that is made by any three players representing any one club wins the team cup.

CURRANS MEMORIAL LOW NET TROPHY

Trophy donated in memory of Bill Currans by his daughter, Anne Farthing, in 2003. The trophy will be presented to the player who has the low net score on qualifying day. In the event of a tie, there will be a scorecard playoff.

PRACTICE ROUND

Each contestant may play one (1) free practice round between June 1 - 21 (cart fee of \$15 is not included) after their registration has been received. You **MUST** call for a tee time.

(Pro Shop – 502-570-9849)

Additional rounds may be played. The cost is \$33.00 for weekday and \$40.00 for weekend play. This includes the cart. You **must** call for a tee time.

W.K.S.G.A. REGULATIONS

A current U.S.G.A. GHIN handicap card must accompany each entry. Attestation from club pro will be accepted **BUT** the player will not be eligible for the Currans Trophy.

The tournament will be conducted under U.S.G.A. rules with such exceptions as the Tournament Committee may announce.

Pairings and starting times will be mailed to all contestants approximately 1 week prior to the tournament.

The Championship Flight will consist of the 31 low qualifiers and the defending Champion or the 32 low qualifiers in the event the defending Champion is not entered.

Ties for the last place in the Championship Flight shall be played off, hole by hole. Players thus tied must be available for play at the time of the play-off or forfeit their right to the upper flight. Ties for the last place in other flights will be determined by U.S.G.A. rules.

Ties for Medalist will receive duplicate prizes.

Contestants who are late for their starting times shall be penalized according to U.S.G.A. rules.

Once a contestant has been paired for match play, she is required to play all matches until eliminated unless the Board of Directors approves withdrawal. **Non-compliance with this rule will result in a one-year ban from State Tournament participation.**

Pace of Play will be strictly enforced. For a ruling on any question, consult the U.S.G.A. rules or members of the Rules Committee.
