

## REGULATIONS

### Senior Women's Kentucky Amateur Championship

This tournament is sponsored by the Women's Kentucky State Golf Association conducted under the U.S.G.A. rules with such exceptions as the Tournament Committee may announce by bulletins. Pace of Play will be strictly enforced. For a ruling on any question, consult the U.S.G.A. rules or members of the Rules Committee.

#### Range Finders are ALLOWED.

In case of a tie, there will be a playoff for overall gross winner. Players must be present at the time of playoff or forfeit. Ties for net and gross winners in each group will be played off on the card starting with Hole #1.

#### ENTRY DEADLINE— SEPTEMBER 2

The field is limited to the first 140 earliest postmarked entries.

Entry fees will be refunded only to those on the waiting list and not accepted because of an unusually large number of entries. Should there be illness, injury or death, fees will be returned upon receipt of a completed Refund Request Form. This form may be requested from the Executive Secretary.

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Contestants must be legal residents of Kentucky. A contestant's club must be a member of Women's Kentucky State Golf Association with dues paid for 2009.

Entries are open to women amateur golfers who have reached their 55th birthday on or before September 15, 2009.

A current USGA Handicap card or GHIN number **MUST** be included with all entries (see form).

## STARTING TIMES

Unless otherwise notified, the Freshmen and Sophomores will tee off Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. The Juniors and Seniors will tee off Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. The order will be reversed on Wednesday.

## AGE GROUPS

Prizes will be awarded in five age groups determined by age as of September 15, 2009  
(Date of Birth must be included on entry form)

Freshmen 55-59      Sophomores 60-64  
Juniors 65-69      Seniors 70 -74  
Super Seniors 75 +

Based upon size of flights, low gross and low net prizes will be awarded. There will also be special prizes in each age group on both tournament days. The overall gross winner will be declared the Senior Women's Kentucky State Champion.

A team trophy will be awarded on Tuesday using the lowest three scores from a club.
