Host Course Information

As you are evaluating this information, please keep in mind that entry fee may go up and the amount the club receives is negotiable.

I. Estimated Income for a Field of 112 Participants (We can not guarantee a full field.)

A. From Participant Entry the club will receive:

\$58.00 per participant paid from WKSGA to cover cost of:

- All social functions:
 - Cookout on Sunday,
 - Hor d'oeuvres with Business meeting on Monday (this is optional as we combined the Business meeting with Banquet in 2005)
 - Banquet on Tuesday.
- Tee Prizes given at registration (usually the host clubs can get donations for the Tee Prizes).
- Range balls for the week (\$3.00 per player of the \$58).

112 Participants x \$58.00 = \$6,496.00

\$40.00 per non-contestant guest to cover social functions (in 2005 we had 25)

approximately 10 x \$40.00 = \$400.00

B. Carts – no more than \$30.00 per cart (assumes 2 players @ no more than \$15.00 per person). This is paid by the players. (In 2005 for Mon. – Wed. cart fees paid were \$3,915.00). The Association will collect cart fees from participants for Mon. – Wed. and pay the club on Sunday prior to the tournament to reduce daily pro shop confusion.

Responsibilities the Host Club Assumes

1. Course management and maintenance.
2. Cart availability.
3. All social event organization (with assistance of local and WKSGA Tournament Committees).
4. Local rule sheet in coordination with WKSGA Tournament Committee and Executive Secretary.
5. Registration of players on Sunday.
6. Starters for Monday on both Number 1 and Number 10.
7. Starter for Match Play rounds (Tuesday – Friday) on Number 1 only.
8. Scorers for posting scores (most important is on Monday for qualifying scores)
9. Pin placement sheet.
10. Supply a room for office space to prepare pairings, upload information to the Internet, etc. We will need access to a dedicated phone line for Internet service. Will also need access to a copy machine, if possible.
11. Supply a meeting space for the Board (Sunday and Monday).
12. Tee gifts that the host club would like to present to the players.
13. Local club women to serve on tournament committee.
14. Spotters for various areas of the course.
